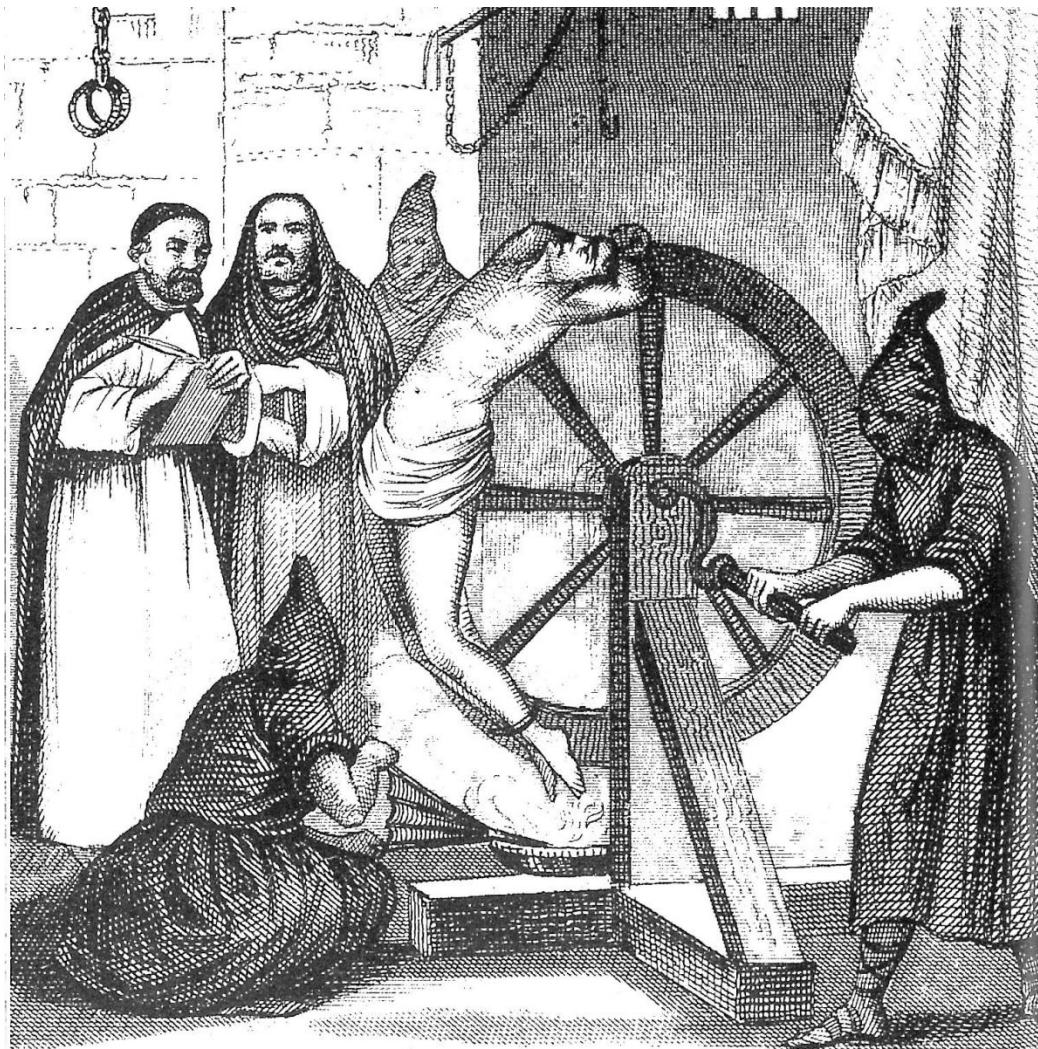
THE EARLY YEARS: PROPHETS AND FANATICS
